13b. The petitioner Mr. X is a student of PSOL who is doing an internship in an NGO, which works for the welfare of the workers. While they were conducting a survey, they found some stone quarries in Dehradun where the workmen were in extreme situations. The working conditions there were very pathetic, unhygienic and unsuitable for these workers who had come from different parts of the country to work. The petitioner wrote a letter to the Chief Justice of India.
