### CASE STUDY

Subhiksha which was initially considered as WAL-MART OF INDIA, has temporarily shut all its 1600 outlets in 110 cities. Analysts believe that there was no problem in its low cost business model," what went wrong? The Chennai based subhiksha trading service was neck-deep in 600 crore of debt. it was not able to pay its vendors because all its earnings were going to service the debt. The company is on the threshold of a closure as it has virtually no money to run its operations.

On one side, there is a viewpoint of imminent closure of the company. But on the other side, there is a strong case to service the company by raising additional Rs 300 crore as a loan and restructuring its existing debt and part with same equity stake by investing a bound investor. This would allow the company to pay off its vendor and restart its operation at the minimum level.

The company went on an expansion plan by opening 800 stores in a year time ,it financed its expansion through debt. The strategy was to dominate the industry and ward off the likely competitors. This expansion would have provided much needed economies its bargaining power with the vendors to fuel its low cost business model.
