The driver and the conductor authorised a person standing nearby to drive the omnibus home. That person drove the omnibus negligently and injured a boy. The boy claims damages from the owners of the omnibus. Are the owners liable?

On 2 June Mr A got a better offer for the goods that remained with him, Can he re-sale the goods? Help Mr A by elaborating his right of re-sale under Sale of Goods Act.
